

Social Hour Instructions

Sundays, 12:15 p.m.



Please allow 40-45 minutes to prepare for Social Hour.

If you'd like to attend the 11:15 a.m. worship service, please arrive at 10:30 a.m.

Before Social Hour

1. Check the long table in the Common Room for any coffee or hot water left over from the 10:30am social hour.
2. Begin to make the coffee and hot water as soon as you arrive (each pot takes 12 minutes to brew). Make 1 pot each of regular coffee, decaf coffee, and hot water. Detailed instructions for using the coffee machine are located in the "How To" binder in the kitchen.
3. While the coffee is brewing, check the long table in the Common Room for coffee cups, sugar, creamer, tea bags, spoons, etc. If any items are missing or low, please replenish them; the items are located in the cabinet to the right of the corner sink or they may be sitting out on the counter.
4. Once all the pots are done brewing, put them on the long table in the Common Room and head to the service!
5. Leave the service during the last hymn.

We ask that you do not bring food to social hour. Instead, please concentrate on making the drinks, setting up the table, and enjoying the company of old friends and new visitors.

During Social Hour

6. Start the dish sanitizer at the beginning of social hour, so it has time to heat up.
7. During social hour, check for anything on the tables that needs to be replenished.
8. If one of the coffee (or hot water) pots is getting low, begin brewing another pot.
9. As people return mugs to the kitchen, load the dish sanitizer racks and, when full, run the dish sanitizer. (Detailed instructions are in the "How To" binder in the kitchen.)

After Social Hour

10. At the end of the social hour, return all items to the kitchen.
11. Wash out the airpots and run mugs, plates, and silverware through the dish sanitizer. Detailed instructions for cleaning the pots and running the dish sanitizer are located in the "How To" binder in the kitchen.
12. Put the dishes and airpots back where they belong.
13. Empty the bowl of used coffee grounds in the compost bin on the south side of Pioneer House. (The quickest way to get there is to go out the exterior door located by the Potter Room.) Rinse the bowl and put it back on the counter next to the coffee machine.
14. Please wipe down the counters and make sure the kitchen is clean and neat.
